DUBAI TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

Passengers holding a UAE Residency Visa that expired before 1st March are not permitted to enter the UAE.

Passengers holding a UAE Residency Visa that expired after 1st March are permitted to enter the UAE until 31st December 2020. Visas will need to be validated within 30 days of entry.

UAE Resident visa holders who have remained outside of the UAE for more than 180 days are permitted to enter the UAE providing the visa is valid.

Visas issued by all other Emirates can be checked via UAE Authority for Identity & Citizenship (ICA): <https://smartservices.ica.gov.ae/echannels/web/client/default.html#/fileValidity>

UAE Residents with Dubai Issued Residency Visa:

GDRFA Approval is required to return to any UAE airport. Approvals can be obtained via https://smart.gdrfad.gov.ae/Smart_OTCServicesPortal/ReturnPermitService.aspx

Dubai residents without GDRFA Approval shall not be accepted for travel.

UAE Residents with Residency Visa issued by another Emirate:

UAE Residents entering the UAE with a residency visa issued in another emirate (Not Dubai) are required to confirm their visa status prior to booking a ticket. Passengers are required to check visa status via the UAE Authority for Identity & Citizenship (ICA) website; <https://uaeentry.ica.gov.ae>.

PCR Testing Requirements prior to travel:

All passengers entering or transiting through Dubai must be in possession of a valid COVID-19 PCR test result (written in English or Arabic). The PCR test result is valid when all the following criteria is achieved:

Test result is NEGATIVE (or NOT DETECTED).

Test was conducted within 96 hours of flight arrival in Dubai.

Test was conducted by a medical facility accredited by Pure Health (<https://screening.purehealth.ae/application>) or by a laboratory accredited in the state of departure.

The test certificate issued by the medical facility is authentic and not altered.

**** 96 hour validity time period begins from time/date sample was taken.**

**** PCR testing is not required for children under the age of 12 or passengers of determination with moderate or severe disabilities.**

PCR Testing on Arrival in Dubai:

Passengers arriving from the following countries will be required to complete a PCR test on arrival in Dubai: Afghanistan, Armenia, Brazil, Bangladesh, Djibouti, Egypt, Eritrea, India, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Montenegro, Nigeria, Pakistan, Philippines, the Russian Federation, Serbia, Somaliland, South Africa, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Tajikistan, Tanzania, Turkey, Turkmenistan, the United States (any port in California, Florida or Texas) or Uzbekistan.

After completing the PCR test passengers must quarantine until the results are received. If a POSITIVE test result is received, then quarantine must continue for a total of 14 days and follow Dubai Health Authority (DHA) guidelines.

Health Declaration & Quarantine Undertaking Forms:

All passengers must complete both Health Declaration form and quarantine undertaking form prior to check in.

Health Insurance:

All passengers entering, or transiting Dubai, must hold valid health insurance. For tourists this is normally achieved with valid travel insurance. This does not apply to the following passengers:

UAE Nationals,

UAE Residents,

GCC Nationals,

Holders of new employment visa

DXB COVID Smart App:

Before arrival in Dubai, all arriving passengers must download the COVID-19 DXB Smart App and register with the Dubai Health Authority. The App can be downloaded from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.
