Requirements for all passengers arriving in Dubai

From today, passengers travelling to Dubai from all countries (GCC included) must fulfil one of the below requirements:

- Present a <u>valid vaccination certificate</u>(s) reflecting that the passenger is fully vaccinated with a vaccine approved by the WHO or the United Arab Emirates (UAE), and includes a QR code System, Of
- Present a <u>valid Negative Covid-19 Test certificate</u> that should be based on a molecular diagnostic test intended for the qualitative detection of nucleic acid for SARS-COV-2 viral RNA, that is issued within 48 hours from the time of sample collection and issued by an approved health service provider, with a QR code System, **Or**
- Present a <u>valid medical certificate</u> issued by the relevant authorities that the passenger has <u>recovered</u>
 <u>from Coronavirus SARS Cov-19 within a period of one 1 month</u> from the date of recovery to the date of
 arrival, with a QR code System
- For Transit Passenger(s), the rules and conditions for entry at the final destination will apply.
