## Requirements for all passengers arriving in Dubai

From today, passengers travelling to Dubai from all countries (GCC included) must fulfil one of the below requirements:

1. Present a **valid vaccination certificate**(s) reflecting that the passenger is fully vaccinated with a vaccine **approved by the WHO or the United Arab Emirates** (UAE), and includes a QR code System, **OR**
  2. Present a **valid Negative Covid-19 Test certificate** that should be based on a molecular diagnostic test intended for the qualitative detection of nucleic acid for SARS-COV-2 viral RNA, that is issued within 48 hours from the time of sample collection and issued by an approved health service provider, with a QR code System, **OR**
  3. Present a **valid medical certificate** issued by the relevant authorities that the passenger has **recovered from Coronavirus SARS Cov-19 within a period of one 1 month** from the date of recovery to the date of arrival, with a QR code System
- ✚ For Transit Passenger(s), the rules and conditions for entry at the final destination will apply.
