

## Your clients can travel safely to Beirut

Dear Valued Travel Partner,

We are delighted to be flying to Beirut again. At Qatar Airways, we continue our commitment to getting your clients where they need to be safely.

In line with the latest travel regulations from the Directorate General of Civil Aviation in Lebanon, starting 1 July there will be a mandatory COVID-19 medical test required for all passengers upon their arrival to Beirut Rafic Hariri International Airport, at a cost of USD 50 per person. Please note children below the age of 12 years are exempted from this test.

To ensure your clients' journey to Beirut is hassle-free, please follow these guidelines:

## For existing tickets to Beirut:



A medical test fee should be collected from clients in advance to reissue their tickets

This fee will be collected as additional YR tax when reissuing the

tickets

After tickets are reissued, the following remark needs to be inserted in the PNR for each passenger: 'SSR CKIN QR COVID19 TEST FEE AT BEY APT COLLECTED ON YR TAX TICKET 157 1234567890/S1/P2'

1571234567890 stands for the new ticket number

SSR remark will be associated by passenger and segment DOH-BEY

For new bookings to Beirut:\*



The medical test fee will be incorporated automatically as additional YR tax for each ticket

After tickets are issued, the following remark needs to be inserted in the PNR for each passenger: 'SSR CKIN QR COVID19 TEST FEE AT BEY APT COLLECTED ON YR TAX TICKET 157 1234567890/S1/P2'

1571234567890 stands for the ticket number

SSR remark will be associated by passenger and segment DOH-BEY

Additionally, when arriving to Beirut, a valid medical insurance will be required from your clients by the authorities, which covers treatment for COVID-19. This is required alongside a health declaration form, which will be available on board our aircraft.
