## Restrictions on entry to the USA relating to Coronavirus

In view of the Coronavirus outbreak effective 2 March 2020, the TSA directive prohibits Qatar Airways from boarding persons to ports of arrival in the United States, if a person has been present in the Islamic Republic of Iran within the preceding 14 days i.e. 14 days prior to their date of arrival into the US.

The above restriction DOES NOT apply to:

- United States citizens holding a United States Passport.
- Lawful permanent residents of the United States holding a Permanent Resident Card or Letter of Parole

If any passenger, in above categories, has originated in, transferred from, or transited through Islamic Republic of Iran within the preceding 14 days, the individual must only travel to the United States on a flight to one of the following approved landing locations.

- John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK), New York
- Chicago O'Hare International Airport (ORD), Illinois
- Los Angeles International Airport (LAX), California
- Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL), Georgia
- Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD), Virginia
- Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport (DFW), Texas

Effective 13 March 2020 below airports have been also added to the approved landing locations for above mentioned passenger categories that hold a United States Passport or valid resident permit.

- Miami International Airport (MIA), Florida
- Edward L Logan International Airport (BOS), Massachusetts

### Important note:

- Transiting via United States (ATL/JFK/LAX/ORD/IAD/DFW/MIA/BOS) to any destination other than USA is only permitted for United States citizens holding a United States Passport or valid resident permit.

**Example: Canadian citizens holding a Canadian Passport cannot travel to Canada transiting United States.**
