

**Dear Customer,**

In addition to Qatar Airways RT-PCR medical test requirements, due to constant updates, all passengers are requested to check and adhere to all the entry regulations published by the government of the destination country before travelling.

We would like to reiterate that Qatar Airways requires all passengers travelling from Iran on Qatar Airways flights to take a RT-PCR test within 96 hours prior departure. The nose/throat swab test for PCR should be done from laboratories authorized by Ministry of Health of Islamic Republic of Iran. At the time of check-in, passengers must possess two copies of the negative RT-PCR test result and must submit it along with a filled up consent form.

The laboratories authorized to conduct test for international travelers is marked with asterisk (*).

Exemptions:

These exemptions apply on Qatar Airways requirements only, while different destination country regulations may still be applicable.

- a. Children under 12 years are exempted from the RT-PCR test if travelling with their family who are holding a negative test.
- b. Infants are also exempted from RT- PCR test requirements.

Children under 12 years travelling as UM (unaccompanied minor) are must take the RT-PCR test and hold negative test result certificate from the authorized medical center.
